



As expert in providing access to learning and research resources, XJTLU Library have integrated our Discover searching platform with ICE, enabling lecturers to add library resources to the reading lists for their students.

This guide shows you how to create reading lists for modules using Reading List plug-in.




First, "Start editing" your module and select "Reading List" when you "Add an activity or resource".





Then, edit the general information for the reading list. First, type in the name of the activity. Click "save and return to module" button at the bottom to save the setting.



Then the reading list is added to the module page. Please click the activity to search for library resources.






Then you can conduct a search in the search box.




You may select the materials in the search result page to build the reading list. On the left hand side of the page, the "Refine Search" can help you to get more desirable results. You can click the collapsed menus to add more advanced search options.






Your reading list is on the top left conner of the page.




You can click on the title of each resource to see the details. You can add the resource to reading list in the detail page (1). Also you can click "View in XJTLU Discover" to see the detailed record in Discover (2). If the resource has a digital version, the "PDF full text" or "LinkSource_Full Text" link on the page allows you to view the full text (3).





The detailed record in Discover may provides more related information, such as books with similar contents or written by the same author.





When **off-campus**, the detail page changes. The "View in XJTLU Discover" button disappears and is replaced by a VPN notice. The "Full Text" button in the search result page is available for full text articles while the "LinkSource_Full Text" becomes disabled. Please login the VPN to get the access.



Reading List

Click "See Current Reading List" to view the resources that have been added to the reading list. Besides the resources added from library resource pages, web resources that you find from other places and not in library resource pages can also be added to the reading list. You can simply type in the URL of the resource and the title for the website.






Then, the web resource you find outside library resource pages is immediately added to the reading list, with the title you just type in. You can click onto the title to see the webpage.



Edit the notes for each reference to tell the students a few key points. The order of the references shown in the list is also sortable.





Then, in student view, they can click into the reading list you add to the module, check the resources and the notes.
